Ex:


Person 1: "I can't believe you spit out that bite of salsa. It's not even spicy. Don't you know spitters are quitters?"





Constantino's Introduces New Internship Program

In order to tighten ties with CWRU students, Constantino's Market recently announced (via in-store flyers) an internship opportunity that will give students an inside look at how to run a retail business. The internship is open to all students not on a pre-health track. with the manager emphasizing the need for students who would "enjoy the experience" and not just take it on to pad their resume. While it is an unpaid position, compensation will be provided in the form of first pick of the damaged goods (you know, the smushed boxes and bruised fruits they cannot put on display for customers). As a 10-week intensive, the supervisors will lead three selected students through five aspects of the job. Starting with shipment unloading, students will also learn the ins and outs of stocking, packaging, label-making (along with how to jack up product prices) and cashier duties in a two week rotation per position. The flyer presents the following as descriptions and requirements for each position.

Unloading: When the trucks roll up, you will roll out to help unload box-

es of products from the back and haul them inside to storage. Interns must be able to lift at least 40 pounds and have a high heat tolerance. Tennis shoes are required.

Stocking: You are expected to be able to work after-hours to stock shelves with fresh-looking produce, push near-expiration products forward, prep the salad bar and ensure the number of Pop-Tarts boxes on the shelf is always 46 (people often steal them). Interns must be at least 5-foot-8 to reach the top shelves.

Packaging: The "A-La-Carte" chefs will take you under their wing for this rotation and show you how to package the freshly made products. From fried chicken to birthday cakes to subpar candies, you will learn how all of our house-made products go from oven to shelf on a daily basis. You must demonstrate good gift-wrapping skills to be considered.

Label-making: This is the most mentally demanding of the jobs. The labels must indicate sale (or regular) price, price per ounce and have no misspellings.
