The Precedent will expand fuel cell research in all schools in the university, according to his University of the State address last Wednesday.

"Fuel cell research is absolutely critical. Once we get a working, practical prototype, we can market it throughout the world," he said.

The Precedent was very optimistic about the future of the new technology. "In three years, no car will ever need gasoline again. Look at the success of the Toyota Prius and tell me there's no market for efficient cars."

Near the end of his speech, the Precedent also said that no matter how much money the big American automakers donate to the Republican party, no self-respecting politician would ever

PRECEDENT SEZ PHILANTHROPY TO INCREASE BY 25 PERCENT PER YEAR

The Precedent announced a 4-year plan to build up university resources by 25 percent each year in last week's University of the State address. He said that this money will come by increasing alumni donations to the level of most top-tier universities.

He said that though it is an extremely large increase in funds over a short period of time, it will be possible to do. He stressed the absolute necessity of funding in improving the reputation of the school as a serious, top-rate institution, and said that he would be willing to require all faculty members to whore themselves on weekends if necessary to meet this goal.

THE UNIVERSITY OF THE STATE

Casa Precedent Hummer gave his first University of the State address of the academic year last week in which he outlined his four-point plan to make the school "really really neato."

Citing educational progress, environment, research and resources and ranch vacations, the Precedent told an audience of administrators and staff that he would do everything he could to make Casa the best school in the country. And he said that the first step was the logo change.

"When we draw our logo, we're doing more than crossing paper clips together. We're making a statement to all seniors in the country who want to apply to MIT: Bring 'em on!" the Precedent said. "Then we'll cut through them like paper clips cutting through paper."

To improve educational progress, the Precedent said that changing the shorthand name of the school from C-to-the-RW to Casa was only the first step. He stated that two years from now the name will be CITf, or Casa Institute of Technology and friends. Then it will be MIT, or Midcleveland Institute of Technology, and finally it will be Super-Happy-Fun-Mega MIT. "Just so the name sticks in people's heads when they hear it," he said.

The Precedent also commented on the school's environment, saying, "University Oval should be the best upper-level education town in the U.S." He cited the symphony orchestra, the artistic, musical and theatrical culture, and the wealth of local museums in support of this statement.

"When a Harvard student wants to see the Boston Symphony Orchestra play, they can't just walk five minutes to get there," he said. "Therefore, when we move the university to Cambridge, Massachusetts, we'll be taking Servantse Hall, the Lagoon and everyone else with us too."

The Precedent used the next 20 minutes to describe his plan of using helicopters and lasers to drop the entire campus onto a lightly populated area just north of the Charles River.

In his discussion of research over the next few years, the Precedent said he would do more to centralize the area health system around the university's medical programs, which is possible here because Casa has the only medical school in the city.

He added that if he tried to make the same suggestion at Harvard, all the other Boston medical schools would not stand for it. Therefore, he will devote resources to produce more helicopters and lasers (with implications toward lasers on helicopters) to deal with the problem when the helicopters and lasers move the school.

Corporate America Embraces New Economy Profit Mechanism: Lawsuits


Following centuries of using outmoded methods of running businesses, the largest corporations in America have shifted gears to what they call, "The way of doing business in the future": lawsuits. "Quite simply, the modern era has proven that producing things such as 'products' are counter-productive toward a healthy business economy," said Bob Gillion, head of the American Association for Large Businesses, or AALB. "It is much easier to file a lawsuit against someone for something and reap in the rewards."

This move comes at a perfect time for Corporate America. After years of being able to sell the same product year after year many corporations have found themselves in financial difficulty as the new generation of consumers often demand innovation on a frequent basis before buying new products. "It is regrettable that the current generation of 16-26 year olds in America has lost all sense in ethics and support for the capitalist system," said Hillary Pock, CEO of RWQ Communications. "From music, to software, to cars, this age group key to our existence demands things such as 'quality' and 'reasonable prices' and refuses to pay for those products if those demands are not met. By switching to a litigation-only profit method the consumer has no choice but to pay us."

In addition to targeting consumers, this new strategy will be used on other corporations as well. "We have recently discovered that about 30 years ago we patented the idea to have a computer smaller then a house," said Charles Balmon, CEO of Balmon Floral Solutions. "After that when computers did become that size, no company ever brought this to our attention and paid the required license for using that idea. They fail to realize that even though we do not produce computers, violation of our intellectual property is illegal and hurts innovation. This shift in corporate direction has encouraged us to sue the industry for over 1.5 trillion dollars in lost revenue over that period of time."

This move has seen nothing but support from the general public. "This move will prove to be






