





The committee shelved a motion to rename Summer Break because a suitable replacement could not be found. They plan to take the issue up again at their next meeting. "We are thinking about holding a naming contest, but we have not worked out the details," said O'Riley.

Milton from Ohio was among a minority of students to actually speak out against the changes. He called the change "unnecessary" and "an affront to our history as a university." He continued, "[The committee] are trying to cover up the history of this university and the fact that it was founded in the northern hemisphere by northern hemisphere people."

"This is political correctness gone too far," said Marcy from Ohio. "First it was the Christians, now it is everyone from the North—all in the name of tolerance."

Scientists Say Global Oxygenation Will Doom Us All

KENORLAND (2,300,000,000 BC) – Oxygen pollution is on the rise, and we are to blame, say leading phototropic autotrophic scientists. They report that the oxygen produced by oxygenic phototrophic organisms has begun to leak into the atmosphere, posing a possible toxic hazard to all life.

"For billions of years, photosynthetic life on planet Earth has been releasing oxygen into its environment with no regard for the long term effects," said one scientist. For billions of years, oxygen, the toxic waste product released by photosynthetic organisms as they capture the much-needed carbon from carbon dioxide, has been absorbed in chemical sinkholes, such as rocks and the ocean. However, recent studies have shown that these sinkholes are now full, and oxygen is now leaking into the atmosphere.

Said one policymaker, speaking on the condition of anonymity, "For billions of years we have taken these sinkholes for granted. In the conclusion the paper, the authors added this warning, "Global oxygenation is a double-edged sword that not only threatens to poison the very species that expel the oxygen, but stimulates the proliferation of predators that can use the oxygen to burn the carbon skeletons of photosynthetic organisms. In turn, bigger predators will come along to eat the smaller predators, and so on and so forth, until the planet is no longer a peaceful place of solitary cells absorbing sunlight, but is instead dominated by a vicious 'chain' of organisms feeding on smaller organisms."

Some skeptics question some of the dire predictions of the global oxygenation theory. "The Autotroph Adaptation Alliance (AAA) does not question the fact that oxygen is rising in concentration in the atmosphere, but we are confident that autotrophs will find a way to adapt to the coming environment," said the group's statement. Other skeptics privately questioned if higher oxygen levels would actually lead to a world that was worse than the one we live in now. One methanogen called the "feeding chain" theory "old-fashioned alarmism" and likened it to predictions of another heavy bombardment that struck the news several millennia ago.

Meanwhile, facultative aerobes have begun to sell oxygen offsets to oxygenic phototrophs wishing to offset their oxygen pollution.

Security Update

Everyone knows the official state rock song of Ohio is "Hang On Sloopy," but did you know the *official state power ballad is "Wind of Change"* by the Scorpions?


